

# Bylaw No 66 1911

A Bylaw to appoint four Deputy-Returning Officers to hold the Elections for Members of the Municipal Council of the Corporation of the Township of Westmeath for the year 1912, and to establish the places for holding the nomination and for polling at the said election

Therefore the Municipal Council of the Township enacts as follows

1<sup>st</sup> That the nomination of Candidates for the Municipal Council of the said Township of Westmeath be held in the Town Hall Beachburg according

to the Statute in that behalf  
2<sup>nd</sup> That Peter Barr of the said Township be and is hereby appointed Deputy Returning Officer at the said election for Electoral District No 1 and that the Town Hall at Beachburg be the Polling place for the said Electoral Division

3<sup>rd</sup> That William Smyth of the said Township be and is hereby appointed Deputy Returning Officer for Polling Sub-division No 2 and that Moore's School House

be the polling place for the said Electoral Division of the said Township

4<sup>th</sup> That Gideon Adams of the said Township be and is hereby appointed Deputy Returning Officer for Polling Sub-division No 3 and that the Public Hall in Westmeath Village be the Polling

Place for the said Electoral Division  
5<sup>th</sup> That George Douglass  
of the said Township be and is hereby  
appointed, Deputy Returning Officer for  
Polling Subdivision No 4 and that the  
School House at Lee's

be the Polling place ~~for the said~~
