A Bylaw of the Municipality of the Township of Westmeath in the County of Renfrew: To improve the main and leading roads within the Municipality

Whereas it is desired to improve the main and leading roads of the Township of Westmeath. By grading, draining, gravelling, or other work of a substantial character, at a total estimated cost of two thousand two hundred dollars

And whereas by an act of the Legislative Assembly of the Province of Ontario 7 Edward the VII chapter 17, being an Act respecting Colonization Roads, certain Townships may prepare and approve a Bylaw - designating any highway or highways to be improved in accordance with the Regulations of the Public Works Department. The Township of Westmeath, being one of such Townships described in the said act

And Whereas upon the completion of any such work of improvement, the Lieutenant Governor-in-Council upon the recommendation of the Minister of Public Works, may direct that a sum not less than one half of the estimated cost may be paid to the Municipality out of any appropriation made by the Legislative Assembly for that purpose.

Therefore the Municipal Council of the Corporation of the Township of Westmeath, enacts as follows -

I That the highways to be improved under this Bill, and the amounts to be expended for each shall be—

No 1 Commencing at

On the Beachburg and Pembroke Road through part of Lot 13 in concession 2 E.M.L. and part through Lots 13 and 12 in concession 3 E.M.L., a distance of  $\frac{3}{4}$  of one mile the sum of Four hundred and fifty dollars

No 2 On the Beachburg and Westmeath Road between the 6<sup>th</sup> and 7<sup>th</sup> concessions opposite Lots 9, 10, 11, 12, and part of Lot 13. a distance of about  $1\frac{1}{2}$  miles, the sum of Seven hundred dollars

No 3 On the Westmeath and Pembroke Road through Lots 28, 27 and 26 in Range N. F. A. a distance of about  $\frac{5}{8}$  of one mile the sum of Two hundred and fifty dollars

No 4 On the Westmeath and Lapasse Road opposite Lot one and part of Lot two in concession four C.L. Front, a distance of about five eighths of one mile, the sum of Three hundred and fifty dollars

No 5 On the Roche Tendu and Beachburg Road between part of Lots five and six in concession Eight, a distance of three eighths of one mile, the sum of One hundred dollars

No 6 On the Golden and Pembroke Road opposite Lot 3 and part of Lot 4 in concession One West of the Muskrat Lake a distance of about three quarters of one mile, the sum of Three hundred and fifty dollars

shall prepare a copy of this Bylaw, and submit the same to the Minister of Public Works, for his approval of a grant of one-half of the estimated cost of the said improvements on the Roads designated.

Read the first and second times in open Council this 28<sup>th</sup> day of September 1912

Read the third time and finally passed in open Council the seventh day of June 1913
