

A Bylaw to appoint five Deputy-Returning Officers, to hold the Elections for Members of the Municipal Council of the Corporation of the Township of Westmeath for the year 1914, and to establish the place for holding the nomination and to establish polling places at the said Election.

Therefore the Municipal Council of the Corporation of the Township of Westmeath enacts as follows -

1 That the nomination for Candidates for the Municipal Council of the said Township of Westmeath be held in the Town Hall Beachburg

2 That Peter Barr of the Village of Beachburg, be and is hereby appointed Deputy Returning Officer at the said election for Polling Subdivision No 1, and that the Town Hall Beachburg be the Polling place for the said Electoral Division

3 That William Smyth of the Township of Westmeath be and is hereby appointed Deputy Returning Officer for Polling Subdivision No 2, and that Moore's School House be the polling place for the said Electoral Division

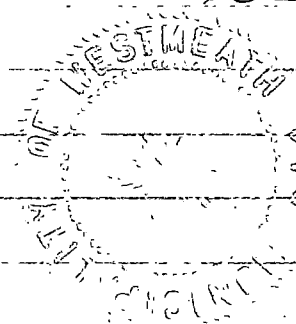
4 That Gideon Adams of the said Township of Westmeath be and is hereby appointed Deputy Returning Officer for Polling Subdivision No 3 and that the Public Hall in the Village of Westmeath be the Polling place for the said Electoral Division

5th That George Douglas of the said Township of Westmeath be and is hereby appointed Deputy Returning Officer for Polling Subdivision No 4 and that Lee's School house be the Polling place for the said Electoral Division

6th That Joseph Lapasse of the said Township of Westmeath be and is hereby appointed Deputy Returning Officer for Polling Subdivision No 5. and that the School House at Lapasse be the Polling place for the said Electoral Division
