

# BY- AW NO. 834

## A BY-LAW TO EQUALIZE FOR COUNTY PURPOSES THE ASSESSMENT ROLLS OF THE LOCAL MUNICIPALITIES IN THE COUNTY FOR 1912.

WHEREAS it is provided by Section 81 of the Assessment Act of Ontario, being Chapter 23, 1904, that each County Council shall yearly and not later than the first day of July, by by-law, for the purpose of County rates, increase or decrease the aggregate valuations of the several municipalities so as to produce a just relation between them but not so as to reduce the aggregate valuation for the whole County as made by the Assessors.

AND WHEREAS the Committee of this Council specially appointed thereto have in Schedule "A" to their report annexed exhibited the aggregate valuations of each Local Municipality as set down by their several assessors on the assessment rolls of 1912, and the aggregate for the whole County is \$16,440,116.

AND WHEREAS the said Committee has also in the said Schedule set forth and recorded the several aggregate valuations of each local municipality as by them equalized which said equalized valuations have been approved and adopted by this Council and the aggregate equalized valuation for the whole County is \$18,525,349.

AND WHEREAS the said local valuation and the said equalization thereof as they appear in the said schedule "A" in respect of each of the said local Municipalities to which they severally relate are as follows, viz.:

Therefore the Council of the Corporation of the County of Renfrew hereby enacts as follows:

That the detailed statement of the equalized valuation of the assessment rolls of this County for the year 1912 as above shown is hereby confirmed, and the aggregate of the said equalized valuation for the whole County, viz.: \$18,525,349, shall be the basis upon which the County rate for the year ending the 31st day of December, 1914, shall be calculated and levied.

And it is hereby further determined and declared that this Council is willing to have the final equalization of the assessment, in case of appeal, made by the County Judge.
