

A Bylaw to assess and Levy rates and taxes for County, Township General and Public School purposes for the year 1914

Therefore be it enacted by the Municipal Council of the Corporation of the Township of Westmeath in the County of Peipow

That the following sums be levied on, and collected from all the rateable property in the Township of Westmeath for the year 1914

1 That the sum of \$ 3512.56 is hereby levied upon and shall be collected from all the rateable property in the said Township of Westmeath for County purposes for the year 1914 at a rate of 1.93 mills on the \$

2 That the sum of \$ 1686.00 is hereby levied upon and shall be collected from all the rateable property in the said Township at a rate of .95 mills on the \$ for Township purposes for the year 1914

3 That the sum of \$ 5716.00 be and is hereby levied upon and shall be collected from all the rateable property in the said Township for General School purposes at a rate of 3.22 Mills on the \$ for the year 1914

4 And it is further enacted that the following rates on the dollar shall be levied upon and collected from all the rateable property in the said Township included within the limits of the several school sections hereinafter

and it is further enacted that the sum of \$691.88 shall be levied upon and collected from all the taxable property within the limits of School Section No 2 in the said Township of Westmeath for the purpose of paying school debentures for the year 1914 at a rate of 3.5 mills on the dollar

And it is further enacted that the rates imposed by this Bylaw, shall be collected and paid over to the Treasurer of the Corporation of the Township of Westmeath on or before the 31st day of December, 1914, by the collector of rates and taxes, in as far as the law will enable him to do so.
