

Bylaw No 139 1915

A Bylaw to appoint Road Commissioners, and to apportion the amount to be expended by each in their several divisions, which shall not be exceeded by them without permission of the Council, except to build bridges which shall ~~not~~ cost over fifty dollars each

Whereas it is necessary to pass a Bylaw for the appointment of Road Commissioners, and to limit the amount of their expenditures for the current year

Therefore be it enacted by the Municipal Council of the ~~Township~~ <sup>Corporation</sup> of Westmeath as follows

That John H. Lyttle of the Township of Westmeath be and is hereby appointed Road Commissioner for road division No 1 and the amount he is authorized to expend is \$ 975.<sup>00</sup>

That John Bennie of the Township of ~~Westmeath~~ <sup>Westmeath</sup> be and is hereby appointed Road Commissioner for road division No 2 and the amount ~~he is~~ <sup>he is</sup> authorized to expend is \$ 788.<sup>00</sup>

That James Mc Mullen of the Township of Westmeath be and is hereby appointed Road Commissioner for road division No. 3 and the amount he is authorized to expend is \$ 685.<sup>00</sup>

That Henry Robinson of the Town-  
ship of Westmeath be and is hereby  
appointed Road Commissioner for Road  
Division No 4 and the amount he  
is authorized to expend is \$ 754<sup>00</sup>

That Robert A. Graham of the Town-  
ship of Westmeath be and is hereby  
appointed Road Commissioner for Road  
Division No 5 and the amount  
he is authorized to expend is \$ 691<sup>00</sup>
