

A Bylaw to assess and levy rates and taxes for War, County, Township, General and Public ^{Elementary} School purposes for the year 1915

Therefore be it enacted by the Municipal Council of the Corporation of the Township of Westmeath in the County of Kennewick

That the following sums be levied on and collected from all the ratable property in the Township of Westmeath for the year 1915

1 That the sum of \$ 1928.00 is hereby levied upon and shall be collected from all the ratable property in the said Township of Westmeath for War purposes for the year 1915 at a rate of 1.1 mills on the \$

2 That the sum of \$ 4530.80 is hereby levied upon and shall be collected from all the ratable property in the said Township for County purposes at a rate of 3.53 mills on the \$ for the year 1915

3 That the sum of \$ 2681.18 is hereby levied upon and shall be collected from all the ratable property in the said Township for Township ~~Township~~ purposes at a rate of 1.5 mills on the \$ for the year 1915

4 That the sum of \$ 5450.00 be and is hereby levied upon all the ratable property in the Township of Westmeath for General School purposes for the year 1915 at a rate of 3.17 mills on the \$

5 and it is further enacted that the following rates on the dollar shall be levied up and collected all from all the taxable property in the said Township included within the limits of the several school sections hereinafter mentioned respectively for the year 1915-
