

Bylaw No 163 1916

A Bylaw to assess and levy rates and taxes for War, County Township General, Public and Separate School purposes for the year 1916

Therefore be it enacted by the Municipal Council of the Corporation of the Township of Westmeath in the County of Pelee

That the following sums be levied on and collected from all the rateable property in the Township of Westmeath for the year 1916

1 That the sum of \$6940.80 is hereby levied upon and shall be collected from all the rateable property in the said Township of Westmeath for war, and county purposes for the year 1916 at a rate of 3.85 mills on the dollar

2 That the sum of \$1802.00 is hereby levied upon and shall be collected from all the rateable property in the said Township of Westmeath, for Township purposes at a rate of 1 mill on the dollar for the year 1916

3 That the sum of \$5450 be and is hereby levied on all the Public School property in the said Township of Westmeath at a rate of 3.15 mills on the dollar for General School purposes for the year 1916

4 And it is further enacted that the following rates on the dollar be levied upon and collected from all the rateable property in the said Township, included within the limits of the several school sections herein after mentioned respectively,

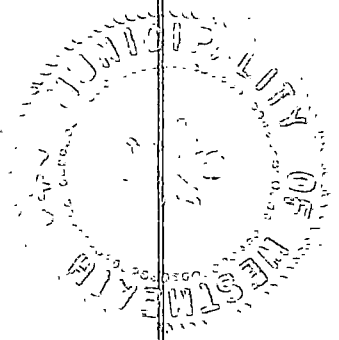
