

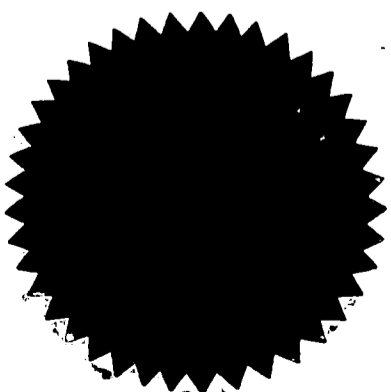
IN THE MATTER of the Application
of The Snake River Telephone
Company, Limited, under the
provisions of Subsection (1)
of Section 9 of "The Ontario
Telephone Act", for an Order
approving By-law No. 172,
Township of Westmeath.

UPON THE APPLICATION of the Applicant, and
upon reading certified copy of By-law No. 172, of
the Municipal Corporation of the Township of
Westmeath.

THE BOARD ORDERS that, subject to the provisions
of Subsection (6) of Section 26 of "The Ontario
Telephone Act", the said By-law No. 172 of the
Municipal Corporation of the Township of Westmeath,
in the County of Renfrew, granting to the Applicant
the right to use certain of the Highways in the
aforesaid Municipality for the erection of poles
and wires for the purpose of the business of the
said Applicant, be and the same is hereby approved.

AND THE BOARD MAKES NO ORDER for costs, save
and except that the Applicant shall pay \$1.50 for
the Law Stamps required for this Order.

BY-LAW NO. ¹⁷².....of the Municipal Corporation of the Township of Westmeath, to authorize The Snake River Telephone Company, Limited, to erect and maintain poles, wires or cables upon the highways in the said Township, hereinafter set forth.

WHEREAS, The Snake River Telephone Company, Limited, has requested the Council of the Corporation of the Township of Westmeath, to permit it to erect telephone lines and poles on certain highways in the said Township of Westmeath, and it is deemed expedient to grant the request of the said Company, subject to the approval of The Ontario Railway and Municipal Board first being had thereto.

BE IT THEREFORE ENACTED by the Corporation of the Township of Westmeath, and it is hereby enacted as follows, that is to say:--

1. That The Snake River Telephone Company, Limited, be and is hereby authorized and empowered to construct telephone lines and to erect the necessary poles and wires for the same and to maintain and keep up the same upon the highways of the said Township of Westmeath, ^{hereinafter set forth} and to use certain of the said highways of the said Township of Westmeath, for placing in, upon, over or under the same, the poles, cables, ducts and wires necessary for the purpose of its business, viz:--

Along the Highway between Concessions 1 + 2 W.M.L. from Lot 14 to the Town Line between the Townships of Westmeath and Ross - along the side line between Lots 5 + 6 in Concessions 1 + 2 W.M.L. Along the side line between Lots 10 + 11 in Concessions 1 + 2 W.M.L. Along the highway through Lot 13 in Concession 2 W.M.L. to the Lake Road, thence along the said Lake Road through Lots 11 to 15 in Concession 2 W.M.L. in the said Township of Westmeath.

2. That the construction of the said telephone lines, and the erection of the said poles and wires shall be carried out in accordance with the specifications prescribed by The Ontario Railway and Municipal Board and under the supervision of the Council of the Corporation of the Township of Westmeath or its Commissioner appointed for that purpose, and a plan showing the location of the said line or lines shall be filed in the office of the Municipal Clerk of the said Township before the said lines shall be constructed.

3. That the said telephone lines, poles, wires or cables shall be erected so as not to interfere with the lines, poles and works of any other telephone or telegraph company at present constructed upon any such highway.

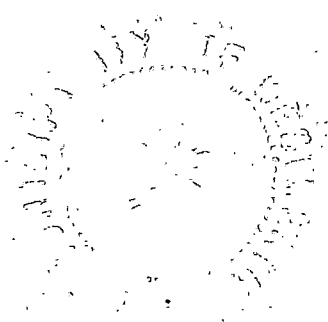
4. That the said telephone lines, poles, wires or cables shall be so constructed, erected and maintained as shall not interfere with the public right of travelling on or using highways, roads, streets, bridges, waters or water courses.

5. That the said The Snake River Telephone Company, Limited, shall indemnify the Corporation of the Township of Westmeath against any actions or claims for damages which may be brought against the said Corporation for or by reason of the construction, operation and maintenance of the said works.

6. This By-law is subject to the approval of The Ontario Railway and Municipal Board first being had and obtained thereto.

Done and finally passed under the seal of the Corporation of the Township of Westmeath, this *eleventh* day of November, A. D. 1916.
