

Bylaw No 174 1916

A Bylaw to appoint five Deputy-Returning Officers to hold the elections for members of the Municipal Council of the Corporation of the Township of Westmeath for the year 1917 and to establish the places for holding the nomination and polling places at the said election.

Therefore the Municipal Council of the Corporation of the Township of Westmeath enacts as follows

- 1/ That the nomination of candidates for the Municipal Council of the said Township of Westmeath be held in the Town Hall Beacomb
- 2/ That Peter Barr be and is hereby appointed Deputy Returning Officer at the said Election for Polling Subdivision No 1 and that the Town Hall Beacomb be the polling place for the said polling subdivision
- 3/ That Wm Smyth of the Township of Westmeath be and is hereby appointed Deputy Returning Officer for Polling Subdivision No 2 and that Moore's School House be the polling place for the said polling subdivision
- 4/ That William Adams of the Township of Westmeath be and is hereby appointed polling Deputy Returning Officer for Polling Subdivision No 3 and that the Public Hall Westmeath be the polling place for the said Subdivision
- 5/ That George Douglas of the Township of Westmeath be and is hereby appointed Deputy Returning Officer for Polling Subdivision No 4 and

H.S.M.

That Lees School House be the
Polling Place for the said Polling
Subdivision
6 That Joseph Laflamme of the
Township of Westmeath be and
is hereby appointed Deputy Returning
Officer for Polling Subdivision No
5 and that the placement of the
separate school be the Polling Place
for the said Subdivision
