A Bylaw to appoint Road Commissioners and to apportion the amount of money to be expended by each, in their several divisions, which shall not be exceeded by them without permission of the Council, except to build bridges which shall ~~not~~ cost over fifty dollars each.

Whereas it is necessary to pass a Bylaw for the appointment of Road Commissioners and to limit the amount of their expenditure for the current year.

Therefore be it enacted by the Municipal Council of the Corporation of the Township of Westmeath as follows.

That John H. Lyttle of the Township of Westmeath be and is hereby appointed Road Commissioner for Road Division No 1 and the amount he is authorized to expend is \$1014⁵⁰.

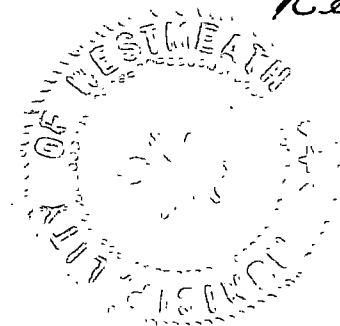

appointed Road Commissioner
