

By law No 196 1917

A Bylaw to appoint Five Deputy Returning Officers to hold the election for Members of the Municipal Council of the Corporation of the Townships of Westmeath for the year 1918. And to establish the places for holding the nomination and Polling places at the said election.

Wherefore the Municipal Council of the Corporation of the Township enacts as follows:

1 That the nomination of candidates for the Municipal Council of the said Township of Westmeath be held in the Town Hall Rathdowne.

2 That Peter Barry be and is hereby appointed Deputy Returning Officer at the said election for Polling subdivision No 1 and that the Town Hall be the Polling place for the said polling subdivision.

3 That Wm Smyth of the Township of Westmeath be, and is hereby appointed Deputy Returning Officer for Polling subdivision No 2 and that Moyross School House be the Polling place for the said Polling subdivision.


4 That William Adams of the Township of Westmeath be and is hereby appointed Deputy Returning Officer for Polling subdivision No 3 and that the Public Hall Westmeath be the Polling place for the said Polling subdivision.

5 That George Douglas of the Township
of Westmeath be and is hereby ap-
pointed Deputy returning Officer for polling
Subdivision No 4 and that Lees
School house be the polling place
for the said polling Subdivision

6 That Joseph Laflamme of the Town-
ship of Westmeath be and is hereby
appointed Deputy Returning Officer
for polling Subdivision No 5 and
that the basement of the Separate
School at Lapasset be the polling place
for the said polling Subdivision
