Whereas it is necessary to pass a Bylaw to pay out certain sums of money

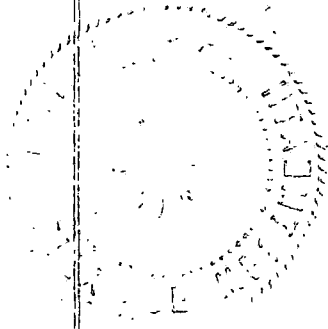
Therefore be it enacted by the Municipal Council of the Corporation of the Township of Deepmeath as follows
