

Bylaw No 207-1918

a Bylaw to appoint Road Commissioners and to limit the amount of their expenditures for the year 1918

Whereas it is necessary to pass a Bylaw to appoint Road Commissioners.

Therefore the Municipal Council of the Corporation of the Township of Westmeath enacts as follows

That John H. Lytle of the Township of Westmeath be and is hereby appointed Road Commissioner for Road Division No 1 and the amount he is authorized to expend is \$900<sup>00</sup>

That William A. McMullen of the Township of Westmeath be and is hereby appointed Road Commissioner for Road Division No 2 and the amount he is authorized to expend is \$750<sup>00</sup>

That James McMullen of the Township of Westmeath be and is hereby appointed Road Commissioner for Road Division No 3 and the amount he is authorized to expend is \$630<sup>00</sup>

That Henry Robinson of the Township of Westmeath be and is hereby appointed Road Commissioner for Road Division No 4 and the amount he is authorized to expend is \$690<sup>00</sup>

That William Purcell of the Township  
of Westmeath be and is hereby appointed  
Road Commissioner for Road Division  
No 5 and the amount he is authorized  
to expend is \$630.<sup>00</sup>
