

By-law No. 260 of the Municipal Corporation of the Township of Westmeath, to authorize The Alba Telephone Company, Limited, to erect and maintain poles, wires or cables upon the highways in the said Township.

WHEREAS, The Alba Telephone Company, Limited, has requested the Council of the Corporation of the Township of Westmeath to permit it to erect telephone lines and poles on certain highways in the said Township of Westmeath, and it is deemed expedient to grant the request of the said Company, subject to the approval of the Ontario Railway and Municipal Board first being had thereto.

BE IT THEREFORE ENACTED by the Corporation of the Township of Westmeath, and it is hereby enacted as follows, that is to say:-

1. That The Alba Telephone Company, Limited, be and is hereby authorized and empowered to construct telephone lines and to erect the necessary poles and wires for the same; and to maintain and keep up the same upon the highways of the said Township of Westmeath, and to use certain of the said highways of the said Township of Westmeath for placing in, upon, over or under the same, the poles, cables, ducts and wires necessary for the purpose of its business, viz:-
Government Road from Pembroke Tp. to Lot 14, Con. 1 EML.
Government Road across N F A from Lot 17 to Lot 24.
Road between Pembroke and Westmeath Townships.
Road between Cons. B and 2 EML from Pembroke Township across Muskrat River, and thence along road between Cons. 1 and 2 WML from Lot 13 to Lot 13.
Roads between Lots 15 and 16, and Lots 18 and 19, Con. 1 WML.
Road between Westmeath and Stafford Townships, from Lot 12 to Lot 20 Con. 1 WML.
Road between N F A and Lot 19 Con. 1 EML.
Road between Cons. 1 and 2 EML from Lot 16 to Lot 19.
Road between Cons. A and 1 EML from Lot 14 to Lot 20.
Road between Lots 20 and 21 Con. A EML.

2. That the construction of the said telephone lines, and the erection of the said poles and wires shall be carried out in accordance with the specifications prescribed by The Ontario Railway and Municipal Board and under the supervision of the Council of the Corporation of the Township of Westmeath, or its Commissioner appointed for that purpose, and a plan showing the location of the said line or lines shall be filed in the office of the Municipal Clerk of the said Township before the said lines shall be constructed.

3. That the said telephone lines, poles, wires or cables shall be erected so as not to interfere with the lines, poles and works of any other telephone or telegraph company at present constructed upon any such highway.

4. That the said telephone lines, poles, wires or cables shall be so constructed, erected and maintained as shall not interfere with the public right of travelling on or using highways, roads, streets, bridges, waters or water courses.

5. That the said The Alba Telephone Company, Limited, shall indemnify the Corporation of the Township of Westmeath against any actions or claims for damages which may be brought against the said Corporation for or by reason of the construction, operation and maintenance of the said works.

6. This By-law is subject to the approval of the Ontario Railway and Municipal Board first being had and obtained thereto.
