

A By-law to appoint Five Deputy Returning Officers to hold the elections for members of the Municipal Council of the Corporation of the Township of Westmeath for the year 1921 and to establish the place for holding the nomination and polling at the said election. Therefore the Municipal Council of the Corporation of the Township of Westmeath enacts as follows:

- 1st That the nomination of candidates for the Municipal Council of the said Township of Westmeath be held in the Town Hall, Beachburg
- 2nd That Peter Barr be and is hereby appointed Deputy-Returning Officer at said election for Polling Subdivision No 1 and that the Town Hall, Beachburg be the Polling place for the said Electoral Division
- 3rd That W^m Smyth of the Township of Westmeath be and is hereby appointed Deputy-Returning Officer for Polling Subdivision No 2 and that Moore's School House be the polling place for the said Electoral Division
- 4th That Jno. R. Fraser of the Township of Westmeath be and is hereby appointed Deputy Returning Officer for Polling Subdivision No 3 and that the Public Hall, Westmeath be the polling place for the said Electoral Division
- 5th That George Smith of the Township of Westmeath be and is hereby appointed Deputy-Returning Officer for polling Subdivision No 4 and

that Lee's School House be the
polling place for the said
Electoral Division.
6th That Wilfred Gerovais of the
Township of Westmeath be and is
hereby appointed Deputy-Returning
Officers for Polling Subdivision No 5-
and that the separate School
House basement at Lapasse be
the polling place for the said
Electoral Division.
