

Beginning at the East end of the
Boundary Line between lot 12 to 16 and lot 1
to 13 and running West the whole length
of the Boundary line to the road which
crosses W F C concession between lot 11 & 10
The whole length of the road which crosses
W F C concession from the Post Office in
Westsmith Village to the Boundary line
on the Ottawa River between Outboard
Lumber between lots 14 & 16 C S F.

Also a side road from Boundary Line north
between lots 10 on the east & lot 11 on the
West to the Coulonge Lake

Between lots 12 & 13 C S F

between lots 5 & 6 S C S F down to

Between lots 5 & 6 A C S F

Road between concessions 14 & 2 C S F

Beginning at lot 1 and ending at lot 10

**Form of By-Law granting to a Telephone Company the right to use
the highways in a Township, under Sec. 8 (1) of "The Ontario
Telephone Act," as approved by the Ontario Railway
and Municipal Board.**

By-law No. 267 of the Municipal Corporation of the Township of *Westmeath*
to authorize The *Bromley Line* Telephone Company, Limited, to erect and
maintain poles, wires or cables upon the highways in the said township.

WHEREAS, The *Bromley Line* Telephone Company, Limited, has requested the
Council of the Corporation of the Township of *Westmeath* to permit it to erect telephone
lines and poles on certain highways in the said Township of *Westmeath*, and it is
deemed expedient to grant the request of the said Company subject to the approval of The
Ontario Railway and Municipal Board first being had thereto.

BE IT THEREFORE ENACTED by the Corporation of the Township of *Westmeath*
and it is hereby enacted as follows, that is to say:—

1. That The *Bromley Line* Telephone Company, Limited, be and is hereby authorized
and empowered to construct telephone lines and to erect the necessary poles and wires for
the same and to maintain and keep up the same upon the highways of the said Town-
ship of *Westmeath* and to use ~~any~~ (*certain) of the said highways of the said
Township of *Westmeath* for placing in, upon, over or under the same, the poles,
cables, ducts and wires necessary for the purpose of its business (*viz:)

2. That the construction of the said telephone lines, and the erection of the said poles
and wires shall be carried out in accordance with the specifications prescribed by The
Ontario Railway and Municipal Board and under the supervision of the Council of the
Corporation of the Township of *Westmeath* or its Commissioner appointed for that
purpose, and a plan showing the location of the said line or lines shall be filed in the office
of the Municipal Clerk of the said township before the said lines shall be constructed.

3. That the said telephone lines, poles, wires or cables shall be erected so as not to
interfere with the lines, poles and works of any other telephone or telegraph company
at present constructed upon any such highway.

4. That the said telephone lines, poles, wires or cables shall be so constructed, erected
and maintained as shall not interfere with the public right of travelling on or using high-
ways, roads, streets, bridges, waters or water courses.

5. That the said The *Bromley Line* Telephone Company, Limited, shall indemnify
the Corporation of the Township of *Westmeath* against any actions or claims for damages
which may be brought against the said Corporation for or by reason of the construction,
operation and maintenance of the said works.

6. This By-law is subject to the approval of The Ontario Railway and Municipal Board
first being had and obtained thereto.

Done and finally passed under the seal of the Corporation of the Township of *Westmeath*
