

A. By-law to appoint Road Commissioners for the Township of Westmeath and to apportion the amount to be expended by each in their several divisions, which shall not be exceeded by them without permission of the Council except to build bridges which may cost over Fifty Dollars each.

Whereas it is necessary to pass a by-law for the appointment of Road Commissioners and to limit the amount of their expenditure for the current year.

Therefore be it enacted by the Municipal Council of the Corporation of the Township of Westmeath as follows:—

That Jno. H. Lyttle of the Township of Westmeath be and is hereby appointed Road Commissioner for Road Division No 1 and the amount he be authorized to expend \$1200⁰⁰

That W. A. McMullen of the Township of Westmeath be and is hereby appointed Road Commissioner for Road Division No 2 and the amount he be authorized to expend \$1065⁰⁰

That W^m T. Gordon of the Township of Westmeath be and is hereby appointed Road Commissioner for Road Division No 3 and the amount he be authorized to expend \$840⁰⁰

That Joseph Stump of the Township
of Westmeath be and is hereby appointed
Road Commissioner for Road Division
No 4 and the amount he be authorized
to expend \$920⁰⁰

That Jas. C. Dennison of the Township
of Westmeath be and is hereby appointed
Road Commissioner for Road Division
No 5 and the amount he be authorized
to expend \$840⁰⁰
