Form of By-Law granting to a Telephone Company the right to use the highways in a Township, under Sec. 8 (1) of "The Ontario Telephone Act," as approved by the Ontario Railway and Municipal Board.

3. That the said telephone lines, poles, wires or cables shall be erected so as not to interfere with the lines, poles and works of any other telephone or telegraph company at present constructed upon any such highway.

4. That the said telephone lines, poles, wires or cables shall be so constructed, erected and maintained as shall not interfere with the public right of travelling on or using highways, roads, streets, bridges, waters or water courses.

5. That the said The Kurshing of Multimed phone Company, Limited, shall indemnify the Corporation of the Township of Multimed second and a solutions or claims for damages which may be brought against the said Corporation for or by reason of the construction, operation and maintenance of the said works.

6. This By-law is subject to the approval of The Ontario Railway and Municipal Board first being had and obtained thereto.
