To open Road Allowance.

WHEREAS it is expedient to open an original allowance for road and establish a highway as hereinafter mentioned.

Be it therefore enacted by the Municipal Council of the Corporation of the Township of Westmeath in the County of Renfrew;

1. That the original Road Allowance between concessions 3 and 4, East of Muskrat Lake, between lots 4 and 5 in the said third and fourth concessions respectively be and ~~are~~^{is} hereby opened as a highway for public travel.

2. The said road allowance is to be sixty-six (66) feet wide, or thirty-three (33) feet on each side of the centre line of the said road.

3. Said bylaw shall come in to force upon the passing thereof.
