

## By-law No.

A By-law to appoint five Deputy Returning officers to hold the election for members of the Municipal Council of the Corporation of the Township of Westmeath for the year 1922 and to establish the place for holding the nomination and polling at the said election

Therefore the Municipal Council of the Corporation of the Township of Westmeath enacts as follows:

1<sup>st</sup> That the nomination of candidates for the Municipal Council of the said Township of Westmeath be held in the Town Hall, Beaulieu and that Peter Barr be and is hereby appointed Deputy Returning officer at said election for Polling Sub-division No. 1. and that the Town Hall, Beaulieu be the Polling place for the said Electoral Division

2<sup>nd</sup> That Wm Smyth of the Township of Westmeath be and is hereby appointed Deputy Returning officer for Polling Division No. 2. and that Morris School House be the Polling place for the said Electoral Division.

3<sup>rd</sup> That Jno Moser of the Township of Westmeath be and is hereby appointed Deputy Returning officer for Polling Sub-Division No. 3. and that the Public Hall, Westmeath be the Polling place for said Electoral Division.

4<sup>th</sup> That N. M. Shields, of the Township of Westmeath be and is hereby appointed Deputy Returning officer for Polling Sub-Division No. 4 and that Keel's School House be the Polling place for said Electoral Division

5<sup>th</sup> That Jos. Laflamme of the Township of Westmeath be and is hereby appointed Deputy Returning officer for Polling Sub-Division No. 5 and that the Polling place be the basement of separate School House, LaSalle for the said Electoral Division
