

A By-law to regulate vehicular traffic in the village of Beachburg, Township of Westmeath

Whereas it is necessary to regulate traffic on certain streets in the village of Beachburg,

Therefore the Municipal Council of the Township of Westmeath hereby enacts as follows:

That it shall be unlawful for any party or parties to park automobiles or any other conveyance on Stewart Street in the village of Beachburg, on any day in which a Fall Fair is in progress, a demonstration, field day, Orange Walk or any other day on which the Agrictural grounds are being used for Public purposes.
