

A BYLAW TO ASSESS AND LEVY RATES AND TAXES FOR COUNTY, TOWNSHIP AND SCHOOL PURPOSES FOR THE YEAR 1924.

WHEREAS IT IS NECESSARY TO PASS A BYLAW TO ASSESS AND LEVY RATES AND TAXES FOR COUNTY, TOWNSHIP AND SCHOOL PURPOSES, THEREFORE BE IT ENACTED BY THE MUNICIPAL CORPORATION OF OF THE TOWNSHIP OF WESTMEATH IN THE COUNTY OF RENFREW, THAT THE FOLLOWING SUMS BE LEVIED ON AND COLLECTED FROM ALL THE RATEABLE PROPERTY IN THE TOWNSHIP OF WESTMEATH FOR THE YEAR 1924.

1. THAT THE SUM OF \$20,265 IS HEREBY LEVIED UPON AND SHALL BE COLLECTED FROM ALL THE RATEABLE PROPERTY IN THE SAID TOWNSHIP OF WESTMEATH, FOR COUNTY PURPOSES FOR THE YEAR 1924, AT A RATE OF 7 MILLS ON THE DOLLAR.

2. THAT THE SUM OF \$3,228 BE AND IS HEREBY LEVIED UPON AND SHALL BE COLLECTED FROM ALL THE RATEABLE PROPERTY IN THE SAID TOWNSHIP OF WESTMEATH AT THE RATE OF 7 MILLS ON THE DOLLAR, FOR TOWNSHIP PURPOSES FOR THE YEAR 1924.

3. THAT THE SUM OF \$157,980 BE AND IS HEREBY LEVIED UPON AND SHALL BE COLLECTED FROM ALL THE RATEABLE PROPERTY OF PUBLIC SCHOOL SUPPORTERS IN THE SAID TOWNSHIP OF WESTMEATH FOR GENERAL SCHOOL PURPOSES AT A RATE OF 6.5 MILLS ON THE DOLLAR FOR THE YEAR 1924.

4. AND IT IS FURTHER ENACTED THAT THE FOLLOWING RATES ON THE DOLLAR SHALL BE LEVIED UPON AND COLLECTED FROM ALL THE RATEABLE PROPERTY IN THE SAID TOWNSHIP OF WESTMEATH INCLUDED WITHIN THE LIMITS OF THE SEVERAL SCHOOL SECTIONS HERINAFTER MENTIONED RESPECTIVELY, FOR THE YEAR 1924.
