

A Bylaw to assess and levy rates and taxes for town, County, Township, General, Public, and separate school purposes for the year 1926.

Therefore be it enacted by the Municipal Council of the Corporation of the Township of Westmeath in the County of Kennebec

That the following sums be levied on and collected from all the ratable property in the Township of Westmeath for the year 1926.

That the sum of 31266.00 is hereby levied upon and shall be collected from all the ratable property in the said Township of Westmeath for County purposes at a rate of 16.9 mills on the \$ for the year 1926.

That the sum of 3145.00 is hereby levied upon and shall be collected from all the ratable property in the said Township for Township purposes at a rate of 1.7 mills on the \$ for the year 1926.

That the sum of \$115.00 be and is hereby levied upon all the ratable property in the Township of Westmeath for General School purposes for the year 1926 at a rate of 6.5 mills on the \$.

And it is further enacted that the following rates on the dollar shall be levied up and collected from all the ratable property in the said Township included within the limits of the several school sections hereinafter mentioned respectively for the year 1926.
