A BY-LAW FOR THE APPOINTMENT OF A WEED INSPECTOR FOR THE MUNICIPALITY OF WESTMEATH UNDER THE NOXIOUS WEEDS ACT.

WHEREAS IT IS DEEMED NECESSARY AND EXPEDIENT TO APPOINT A WEED INSPECTOR FOR THE THE MUNICIPALITY OF WESTMEATH

AND TO HAVE SAID ACT ENFORCED IN ORDER TO HAVE SAID

NOXIOUS WEEDS ELLIMINATED IN SO FAR AS MAY BE POSSIBLE,

NOW THEREFORE, BE IT ENACTED BY THE MUNICIPAL COUNCIL OF

THE CORPORATION OF THE TOWNSHIP OF WESTMEATH AS FOLLOWS,

THAT *W. S. Gygels* OF THE TOWNSHIP OF WESTMEATH BE AND IS HEREBY APPOINTED WEED INSPECTOR FOR THE MUNICIPALITY

OF WESTMEATH, WITH POWER TO ENFORCE THE ACT, AT A SALARY

OF *Three Hundred \$* ^{*x/100*} DOLLARS, TO CARRY OUT THE DUTIES, ^{*for the months of June, July, Aug & Sept.*} *W.S.G.*

AS PERSCRIBED IN THE ACT OR SUCH OTHER WORK AS MAY BE

RELATED, UNDER DIRECTION OF THE COUNCIL.
