

A BY-LAW TO PROVIDE FOR THE PAYMENT OF MONEY

Whereas it is necessary and expediant to provide by BY-LAW for the payment of such accounts grants and allowances as have been otherwise authorized or reccomended for payment at the present session of Council; Therefore the Municipal Council of the Corporation of the Township of Westmeath hereby enacts as follows;
