Re: By-Law

The By-Taw submitted by your Township has been approved in full and the basis on which the Department will contribute is as follows:- Roads expenditure 50%.

A new by-Law form has been prepared which takes care of the expenditure on all Colonization Roads By-Laws on the one form and your By-Law together with a supply of the new forms is herewith enclosed, in order that you may transcribe it on the new form.

The new By-Law form should be forwarded in duplicate and one copy will be returned to you when it approved of. When payment is desired the Declaration of the Treasurer should be completed on your copy and then forwarded to the Department in the usual manner with vouchers, paylists and completed overseer's time book.

You may proceed with the work as soon as you receive the necessary instructions from the Inspector.
