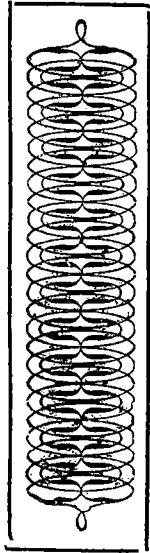

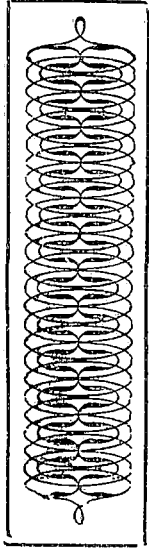

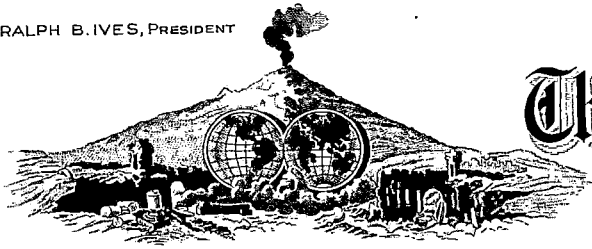

(North and West of the French and Mattawa Rivers and including Manitoulin Island, Trapping Licenses are only issued by officers of the Department.)

If you wish to accept this appointment, kindly sign and return one copy of this agreement, retaining the other for your own information.

#### GAME AND FISHERIES DEPARTMENT:—

In consideration of my appointment as Issuer of Hunting, Trapping and Gun Licenses for the current season, I hereby agree to comply faithfully with the provisions of The Game and Fisheries Act of the Province of Ontario, and all Regulations now in force or which may be enacted hereafter.

I understand clearly that all licenses which may be sent to me are the property of the Crown and that I am responsible for the safe-keeping of same, and that the fees received for the sale of all licenses are also the property of the Crown and must be kept separate from my personal funds and must not be used for any purpose.

I agree to sell all licenses for the amount of the fee and commission as stated on the license, and will not sell any license for either more or less than the amount specified.

In order that there may be no misunderstanding, the following schedule shows the fees to be collected and the amounts to be remitted for all licenses:

It is also understood that I am to keep a reasonable supply of licenses on hand at all times and that the issuing of a receipt in lieu of a license is a direct violation of the Regulations and will render my appointment liable to immediate cancellation. I agree to return all unsold Hunting Licenses to the Department not later than November 25th, 1933, and to forward a final remittance for Hunting Licenses by that date, and also to return all unsold Trapping Licenses to the Department not later than April 21st, 1934, and to forward a final remittance for Trapping Licenses by that date, and to return all unsold Gun Licenses to the Department not later than April 30th, 1934, and to forward a final remittance for Gun Licenses by that date. I also agree to report promptly either to The Department of Game and Fisheries at Toronto, or to the nearest officer of this Department any violations of The Game and Fisheries Act of which I may hear, but this is on the distinct understanding that such information will be considered as having been given in confidence and no use will be made of my name in connection therewith, except with my written consent.

All issuing will be done at my residence or regular place of business and each license will be completed in every respect before it is given to the purchaser. All issuing will be done in accordance with Section 19, which reads as follows:

- 19a. "It shall be unlawful for any issuer of licenses to issue, and for any person, while in a hunting camp, to have in his possession a Hunting License without the name of the licensee filled in, and any person contravening the provisions of this section shall be guilty of an offence against this Act."
- 19b. "It shall be unlawful for any issuer of licenses to issue and for any person to receive any license which had been ante-dated, and any person contravening the provision of this section shall be guilty of an offence against this Act."
- 19c. "It shall be unlawful for any person other than a person authorized within the provision of this Act to issue any licenses or collect any fees in respect of the same, and any person so doing shall be guilty of an offence against this Act."

Under the provisions of Section 20, Sub-section (e) of The Ontario Game and Fisheries Act, Hunting and Gun Licenses must not be issued to any person under sixteen years of age, and under Section 20, Sub-section (f) of The Ontario Game and Fisheries Act, Trapping Licenses must not be issued to non-British subjects.

NOTE:—Should a license be accidentally spoiled, it must be returned to the Department immediately with a short explanation, otherwise credit will not be allowed for it.
