

BY-LAW No. 137

A By-law of the Municipality of Township of Westmeath

entitled a By-law to authorize the construction and improvement of roads within the said Municipality, or the employment of a Road Overseer, or the purchase of machinery, tools and equipment, or any of them, in the year 1935, to the total amount of \$ 3,000.00

Whereas under the Colonization Roads Act, R.S.O. 1927 and amendments thereto, certain Municipalities are authorized to prepare and approve a By-Law or By-Laws.

And Whereas after a By-Law, as aforesaid, has been approved, as provided in the said Colonization Roads Act, and expenditures have been made in accordance with the said Colonization Roads Act, and a Statement has been submitted, by the Council of the Municipality making the expenditure, to the Department of Northern Development setting forth the expenditure made, together with the Declaration of the Treasurer of the said Municipality that such Statement is correct, and on the receipt by the Provincial Treasurer of such Statement and Declaration with the Report and Certificate of the Inspector of Colonization Roads for the District in which the expenditure was made, or an Engineer of the Department, that the said expenditure is in accordance with the aforesaid By-Law, and the regulations of the Department of Northern Development, certified and approved by the proper officer of the Department of Northern Development, the Lieutenant-Governor-in-Council may direct the payment to such Municipal Corporation, as aforesaid, out of the funds voted by the Legislature for that purpose, a sum of not more than the proportion authorized by the Act.

And Whereas under the authority of the "MUNICIPAL ACT of Ontario," the power is given to Municipalities to assess and levy a rate over and above the ordinary statute labor or otherwise provide a sufficient sum to defray the cost of road construction and improvement within the Municipality.

Therefore the COUNCIL of the Municipality of Township of Westmeath in the County or District of Renfrew, enacts as follows:

1. The highway or highways to be constructed or improved under this By-Law, and the amount to be expended on such construction and improvement on each, shall be those which are described and set forth in the "schedule" herewith attached to this By-Law.

2. That (NAME) (ADDRESS) is appointed Township road overseer or superintendent in the said township from the day of , and during the pleasure of the said Council and shall be paid at the rate of \$ per for such time as he may be employed.

3. That machinery or equipment as follows: be purchased.

4. That this By-law, after the second reading thereof in Council, be submitted to the Minister charged with the Administration of the Department of Northern Development, who may approve, alter or modify it, and upon its being amended in accordance with the aforesaid approval, alteration or modification of the said Minister, and finally passed by the Council of the said Municipality, it shall be forwarded to the Department of Northern Development to be kept by them.

5. That the total expenditure under this By-Law shall be 3,000.00 dollars and that the sum of Fifteen Hundred dollars shall be raised locally by the said Municipality for the purpose of defraying the proportion of the cost to be borne by them under this By-Law.

NOTE—By-Laws passed under the Colonization Roads Act, must be submitted to the DEPARTMENT OF NORTHERN DEVELOPMENT, not later than 10 days after the commencement of the Session of the Legislative Assembly at which the grant applied for may be voted.

No amount less than two hundred dollars shall be permitted under this By-Law on any one road.
