

BY-LAW NO.

BY-LAW OF THE CORPORATION OF THE TOWNSHIP OF WESTMEATH FOR THE PURPOSE OF REGULATING THE SPEED OF MOTOR VEHICLES IN CERTAIN PARTS OF THE TOWNSHIP OF WESTMEATH

The Corporation of the Township of Westmeath hereby enacts as follows:

(1) THAT no motor vehicle shall be operated at a greater rate of speed than fifteen miles per hour on any highway within the limits of the hamlets of Beachburg, Westmeath and Lapasse in the said Township of Westmeath.

(2) THAT notices regarding the said speed limit shall be posted on all highways in the said hamlets in compliance with the regulations of the Department of Highways.

Dear Sirs:-

The Reeve and Clerk of the Township of Westmeath have consulted me regarding the passage by the Council of a By-law prohibiting a greater rate of speed than 15 miles per hour within the limits of the hamlets of Beachburg, Westmeath and LaFasse in such Township. These hamlets are rather populous Villages which have never been incorporated as Villages and in the main they consist of practically one street over which all the traffic of the Villages and surrounding district passes.

The officers feel that a speed of 30 miles per hour in these places is very dangerous and asked me to prepare and forward to your Department for approval the enclosed By-law. I wish you would please let me hear from you as to whether or not the approval of the Department can be given thereto.
