

A BY-LAW AUTHORIZING THE ABOLITION OF STATUTE LABOUR IN THE TOWNSHIP OF WESTMEATH
IN THE COUNTY OF RENFREW

WHEREAS this Council is authorized by R.S.O., 1937, Chapter 274, Section 6, to abolish by by-law all Statute Labour within this township.

BE IT THEREFORE ENACTED by the Council of this township, and it is hereby enacted -

(1) That from and after the date of the passing of this by-law no Statute Labour shall be levied or assessed against any person resident or assessed in this municipality.

(2) That the Council shall in each and every year, in lieu of Statute Labour, levy such amount as may be necessary upon the rateable assessment of the municipality to be expended on the construction and maintenance of the roads and bridges of the township.

(3) That all existing by-laws of this township relating to Statute Labour or parts of by-laws, contrary to, or inconsistent with the provisions of this by-law, are hereby repealed.

(4) That a copy of this by-law be forwarded to the Municipal Roads Branch, Department of Highways of Ontario, within one month of the passing thereof.
