

A. BY-LAW APPOINTING A ROAD SUPERINTENDENT IN THE TOWNSHIP OF WESTMEATH IN THE COUNTY OF RENFREW,

Whereas it is desirable that the laying out and supervision of all work and expenditure upon improvement and maintenance of roads within the exclusive jurisdiction of this Township should be under the supervision of a road superintendent, acting under the direction of this Council.

And Whereas it is the desire of this Council to take advantage of The Highway Improvement Act, and to receive the Government Grant as provided in R.S.O. 1937 Chapter 56, Sections 45, 47, 49.

Be it therefore enacted by the Municipal Council of the Corporation of the Township of Westmeath and it is hereby enacted,

1st That CHARLES GARNET KENNY is hereby appointed road superintendent in the said Township to act as aforesaid in accordance with the provisions of the said section 45 of the said Act from the (12th) Twelfth day of APRIL 1941 and during the pleasure of said Council.

2nd That the road superintendent shall be paid at the rate of FIFTY-CENTS (\$0) per hour for such time as he may be so employed, transportation included in above rate,

3rd That it shall be the duty of the road superintendent to lay out and supervise all work and expenditure on roads within the exclusive jurisdiction of the Township Council, and to conform to such general regulations as the Department of Highways may prescribe,

4th That all by-laws or parts thereof and all or any resolutions of said Council contrary hereto or inconsistent herewith, be and the same are hereby repealed.

5th That a certified copy of this by-law be forwarded by the Clerk to the Municipal Roads Branch, Department of Highways, Toronto.

Read a third time and passed this 10th day of October 1942.
