A. BY-LAW TO PROVIDE GRANTS TO MEMBERS OF THE ARMED FORCES.

WHEREAS Sub-section 32 of Section 404, The Municipal Act, being Chapter 266, R.S.O. 1937, as amended by Statutes of Ontario, 1944, provides that the Councils of all Municipalities may, with the approval of the Department of Municipal Affairs, pass By-Laws for the making of grants to persons who have served in the armed forces of His Majesty or His Majesty's Allies during ~~the present war~~: the present war,

AND WHEREAS the Council of the Corporation of the Township of Westmeath deem it expedient and advisable to make grants to members of armed forces:

Therefore be it enacted: by the Municipal Council of the Corporation of the Township of Westmeath, That an amount of Three-Thousand-Six-Hundred-and-twenty-dollars-and-seventy-six-cents (\$3,620.76) be placed in the current estimates and set aside for such purpose.

That such grant be given to such persons, who qualify as above and have been resident in the Municipality ~~for a period of not less than~~ _____

That this By-Law shall come into force and take effect upon the date upon which it is approved by the Department of Municipal Affairs.
