

PETITION RE SNOW-LOWING

No 468 - Nov-9/46

To the Honourable Geo. H. Doucett, Minister of Highways

THE PETITION of the Corporation of the Township of Westmead humbly sheweth as follows:

- 1. YOUR PETITIONERS, as requested by the parties willing to make special contributions towards the cost of the work, desire to undertake the work of snow plowing on the roads under the jurisdiction of the Council of your Petitioners described as follows:

Township Roads

Item A. Total Estimated Expenditure	\$ <u>2000.⁰⁰</u>
Item B. Estimated Subsidy at <u>55%</u> (normal rate)	\$ <u>1100.⁰⁰</u>
Item C. Difference	\$ <u>900.⁰⁰</u>

Distribution of Estimated Expenditure

The Department of Highways (Item B)	\$ <u>1100.⁰⁰</u>
The Corporation (not less than 50% of Item C)	\$ <u>450.⁰⁰</u>
Special Contributions	\$ <u>450.⁰⁰</u>
Total Estimated Expenditure (Item A)	\$ <u>2000.⁰⁰</u>

- 2. The purpose of the said work is snowploughing
Township Roads -

- 4. THIS PETITION has been authorized by resolution of the Council of your petitioners passed on the 9th day of December 1946

YOUR PETITIONERS, THEREFORE, PRAY that you may be pleased to approve the said work and, pursuant to the Highway Improvement Act, as amended by the Highway Improvement Amendment Act, 1944, to consent to the inclusion of the expenditure made on the said work or such portion of the amount thereof, as may be considered proper in the statement submitted for subsidy under the said Act.
