

A BY-LAW TO PROVIDE FOR THE TOTAL 1947 EXPENDITURE ON ROADS IN THE TOWNSHIP

OF WESTMEATH IN THE ~~STATE~~ COUNTY OF RENFREW
DISTRICT

WHEREAS The Highway Improvement Act, Chapter 56, R.S.O., 1937, and amendments, requires that the total expenditure on township roads and bridges be provided for annually by township by-law.

THEREFORE the council of the corporation of the said township enacts as follows:

(1) The sum of \$ 12,000.00 is hereby appropriated from monies raised by levy, debentures and government subsidy for total expenditure upon construction and maintenance of the roads in the said township during the year 1947 as follows:

(2) The said monies shall be expended under the direction of the duly appointed township road superintendent and on work performed in accordance with The Highway Improvement Act.

(3) The clerk shall transmit duplicate copies of this by-law to the Municipal Roads Branch, Department of Highways, for approval on or before February 28th of the present year.

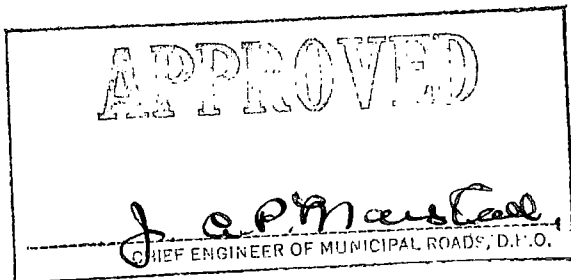
