BE IT THEREFORE ENACTED as a By-Law of the said Council as follows:

1. That the Head and Treasurer are hereby authorized on behalf of the Corporation to borrow from time to time, by way of promissory note, from The Bank of Nova Scotia, a sum or sums not exceeding in the aggregate (\$30.000) Thirty Thousand dollars to meet, until the taxes are collected, the current expenditures of the Corporation for the year, including the amounts required for the purposes mentioned in subsection (1) of the said Section 341, and to give, on behalf of the Corporation, to the said Bank a promissory note or notes and/or other forms of agree ment of the Corporation as may be required by the said Bank, sealed with the corporate seal and signed by the Head and Treasurer for the moneys so borrowed with interest at a rate not exceeding 48

per centum per annum, which may be paid in advance or otherwise.

2. That all or any sums borrowed pursuant to the authority of this By-Law as well as all other sums borrowed in this year or in any previous years from the said Bank for any or all of the purposes mentioned in the said Section 341 shall, with interest thereon, be a charge upon the whole or any part or parts of the revenues of the Corporation for the current year and for all preceding years, as and when such revenues are received.

That the Treasurer is hereby authorized and directed to apply in payment of all sums borrowed pursuant to the authority of this By-Law, as well as all other sums borrowed in this year and in any previous years, from the said Bank for any or all of the purposes mentioned in the said Section 341, together with interest thereon, all of the moneys hereafter collected or received on account or realized in respect of the taxes levied for the current year and preceding years and all of the moneys collected or received from any other source, which may lawfully be applied for such purpose.
