BY-LAW NO. 824

A BY-LAW TO PROVIDE FOR THE TOTAL 19<u>55</u> EXPENDITURE ON ROADS IN THE TOWNSHIP OF <u>Westmeath</u> IN THE COUNTY OF <u>Renfred</u>

WHEREAS The Highway Improvement Act requires that the total expenditure on roads be provided for annually by by-law and that the by-law be submitted to the Minister of Highways for approval.

THEREFORE the Council of the Corporation of the said Township enacts as follows:-

(1) The sum of \$ 3.000 is hereby appropriated from momeys raised by levy, debentures and government subsidy for total expenditure upon construction and maintenance of the roads under its jurisdiction during the year 19 as follows:-

(2) The said moneys shall be expended under the supervision of the duly appointed township road superintendent and on work performed in accordance with The Highway Improvement Act.

Re: 1955 Supplemental Road Expenditure By-law

Please be advised that your By-law No. 824 which provides for an expenditure of § 3,000.00 has received consideration by the Department as a charge against the allotment for Special Capital Projects contained in the Department's estimates for the current fiscal year.

The Honourable Jas. N. Allan, Minister of Highways, has approved of the proposed expenditure to a limit of \$\overline{3,000.00}\$ for subsidy purposes subject to the following conditions:

- 1. That the money shall be used for the purposes set out in the by-law and the accompanying programme and shall not be diverted to any other purpose,
- 2. That the individual works of road construction and bridge construction and the purchase of each unit of equipment or machinery and the award of contracts for same shall be subject to approval,
- 3. That the District Engineer shall be informed and his approval obtained before the proposed work or purchase of equipment is advertised or any commitment is made by the municipality.
