A BY-LAW TO PROVIDE FOR THE 1957 EXPENDITURES ON ROADS IN THE
TOWNSHIP OF Westmeath IN THE COUNTY OF Renfrew
WHEREAS The Highway Improvement Act requires that the total expenditure on roads be provided for annually by by-law and that the by-law be submitted to the Minister of Highways for approval.
THEREFORE the Council of the Corporation of the said Township enacts as follows:-
(1) The sum of \$ 34.000.00 is hereby appropriated from monies provided by levy, debentures and government subsidy for the expenditure upon construction and maintenance of the roads under its jurisdiction during the year 1957 as follows:-

(2) The said monies shall be expended under the supervision of the duly appointed township road superintendent and on work performed in accordance with The Highway Improvement Act. (3) The clerk shall transmit duplicate copies of this by-law to the district office of the Municipal Roads Branch, Department of Highways not later than March 31st of the said year.
