

A BY-Law RESPECTING THE BANKING ACCOUNTS OF THE CORPORATION OF THE TOWNSHIP OF WESTMEATH, AND OTHER RELATIVE BANKING AFFAIRS AND THE SIGNING AUTHORITY OF CERTAIN OFFICIALS OF THE CORPORATION IN RELATION THERETO

THE MUNICIPAL COUNCIL OF THE TOWNSHIP OF WESTMEATH -
enacts as follows;

1. THAT the Bank of Nova Scotia (hereinafter called the "Bank") be and is hereby appointed banker of the Corporation of the Township of Westmeath, hereinafter called the "Corporation".
2. That the Bank is hereby authorized to pay and honour all cheques and orders for the payment of money drawn against any and all of the accounts of the Corporation now open or which may be opened hereafter when signed jointly by the Clerk-Treasurer and the Reeve as appointed from time to time.
3. That the Clerk-Treasurer alone is hereby authorized to arrange, settle, balance and certify all books and accounts between the Corporation and the said Bank and to receive all paid cheques, vouchers, cancelled coupons and debentures and to sign the Bank's form of settlement of balances and release pertaining to all bank accounts of the Corporation.
4. That the Bank is hereby authorized to transfer any sums at any time from the Tax Account to the credit of the General Account.
