

A BY-LAW TO PROVIDE FOR THE 1962 EXPENDITURES ON ROADS IN THE
TOWNSHIP OF Westmeath IN THE COUNTY DISTRICT OF Renfrew

WHEREAS The Highway Improvement Act requires that the total expenditure on roads be provided for annually by by-law and that the by-law be submitted to the Minister of Highways for approval.

THEREFORE the Council of the Corporation of the said Township enacts as follows:

(1) The sum of \$ 48,000.00 is hereby estimated as the expenditure upon the construction and maintenance of the roads and bridges under its jurisdiction during the year 1962 as follows:

(2) The said monies shall be expended under the supervision of the duly appointed township road superintendent and on work performed in accordance with The Highway Improvement Act.

(3) The clerk shall transmit **duplicate** copies of this by-law to the district office of the Municipal Roads Branch, Department of Highways, not later than March 31st of the said year.

(4) The approval of the Ontario Municipal Board shall be obtained before any expenditure is authorized or work commenced which will be financed by the issue of debentures or monies raised in a subsequent year.

Dear Sir: Re: 1962 Road Estimates By-law

Enclosed are three copies of By-law Form MR-16 and supporting Road Programme MR-18 for use when submitting estimates of 1962 normal road expenditures for which your township will claim subsidy under The Highway Improvement Act.

In order that the expenditures for this district may be kept within the amounts allocated to it, it is necessary to advise you that the maximum estimates that may be approved for your township for normal expenditures shall not exceed

\$ 19,000 for Construction and \$ 29,000 for Maintenance.

When preparing the by-law and supporting road programme be careful to see that the various sub-totals on programme agree with the amounts entered in the by-law. Also, all totals should be rounded out to the nearest hundred dollars. Please have regard for the footnote on the Road Programme re Distribution of Overhead, Construction and Maintenance.

~~Duplicate~~ ^{TRIPPLICATE} copies of the completed by-law and programme shall be forwarded to the undersigned not later than March 31st, 1962.

A supplementary by-law and programme for special capital works of a permanent, non-recurrent nature will be accepted for consideration later, if required, but it is necessary to ask that they be submitted not later than July 31st, 1962.
