BY-LAW NO. 63-9

A by-law to authorize the purchase of a

Road Grader

WHEREAS it is deemed expedient that a New Austin-Western

Road Grader be purchased.

AND WHEREAS it is estimated that the cost of the Road Grader
will not exceed Twenty thousand, three hundred ^{seventy-nine}/₁₀₀ (dollars) (\$20,379.50).

THEREFORE the Council of the Corporation of the Township
of Westmeath ENACTS AS FOLLOWS:

1. THAT a New Road Grader be purchased.
2. THAT the Reeve and Clerk-Treasurer are authorized to cause a contract by way of tender for the supplying of the said equipment with some person or persons, firm or corporation, subject to the approval of this council to be declared by Resolution.
3. The Reeve and Clerk-Treasurer may (subject to the approval of the council) agree with any bank or person for temporary advances of money to meet the cost of the undertaking pending completion of it.
4. The loan to be effected to pay for the cost of the Road Grader when finally determined shall bear interest at such rate as the Council may determine and be made payable within 3 years on the instalment plan.
5. THIS by-law shall be subject to the approval of The Ontario Municipal Board.
