

THE CORPORATION OF THE Township OF Westmeath

BY-LAW NO. 63-10

Being a by-law to authorize the borrowing of
\$ 20,379.50 to provide for
purchase of a Road Grader

WHEREAS the Council of the Corporation of the Township
of Westmeath has by by-law authorized the
purchase of An Austin - Western Road Grader

AND WHEREAS it is deemed expedient to borrow for the said
purpose a sum not exceeding \$ 20,379.50 upon
the credit of the Corporation to be raised by way of promissory note.

THEREFORE the Council of the Corporation of the Township
of Westmeath ENACTS AS FOLLOWS:

(1) THAT a sum not exceeding \$ 20,379.50 be borrowed
from the Bank of Nova Scotia in the
Village of Beachburg
for the purposes aforesaid.

(2) THAT the loan of \$ 20,379.50 be repaid
over a period not exceeding 3 years being 1963, 1964, etc.

(3) THAT 3 promissory notes in the amounts of
\$ 10,000, \$ 5200.00 etc. be drawn in
favour of the Bank of Nova Scotia
in the Village of Beachburg
and each of the said notes shall become due and payable in the
respective years 1963, 1964, etc. on the Anniversary of the
date of signing thereof.

(4) The Corporation of the Township of Westmeath
shall levy on all the rateable property in the municipality an
amount over and above all other rates sufficient to meet such
payment including interest.

(5) THAT each promissory note shall bear interest at the
rate of 5 3/4 % per annum.

(6) THAT each promissory note shall be sealed with the seal
of the Corporation signed by the head of council or by some other
person authorized by by-law to sign the same and by the Treasurer.

(7) THAT this by-law shall become effective upon the final passing thereof.
