(d) gamos of a type or kind known as raxzie dazzle, roll down, throe-card monte, punch board, coin table or any dice games are to be operated.

## LICEACES

(d) the grome recelpta derived from the lottory shall be used for the charitable or religious object or purpose as set out by the licensee in the application for liconse, lass the cost of the prizew awarded and moh reasonable and nacessary administrative expenses actualis incurred in the management and conduct of the lottery, provided the expenses do not exceed such limits as may be prescribed by the Minister;
(o) much officers as the municipal council or the Minister may appoint, and all Peace Officerien shall, at all reamonable times; have direct an unencumbered access to enquire into the nature, management and
conduct of the proceedings for which the 1icence has been granted, either prior to, during, os after the conclusion of such proceedings;
(f) the 1icensee ghall submit to the licensing authority, not later than 30 daya after the holding of each licensed lottery, a written report showing,
(i) the total gross recelpts derived from the lottery,
(ii) the total cost of all prizes awarded
(iii) an itemized list of the administrative costis actually incurred in the managemont and conduct of the lattery
(iv) the total cath proceeds donated for charitable or religious pupposes as set forth in the application of the Ifcensee, and the name and address of the payee;
(g) the licenses thall conduct or allow to be conducted only the type of game or games provided in the application and the 1icence: and
(h) the licensea shall produce the licence upon demand
(2) Each raffle lottery licence shall aliso bo subject to the following terms and conditions:
(a) ach individual rafflo scheme must have a 1icence;
(b) the winner or winners shall be determined and publicized in the manner set out in the application;
(e) the charitable or religious organization managing and conducting the licensed raffle shall
(1) Indicate on the face of the ticketa the name and address of the organization, the location, the date, the time at which the draw is to bo held, the number and naturs of the prizes to be awarded, the number of the ticket, and the name of the printer; (ii) retain all unsold tickets and counterfoils of gold tickets for poriod of not less than 90 days from the date of the dxaw, and produce them to such persons as may be authorized under section 7 (1)(e); and
(iv) indicate in its application the number of tickets to be printed for sale.

## SUSPENSTON OR CANCELLATTON OF LICENCE

8) 

The municipal council may suspend or cancel a licence for the breach of any term or condition.
9) The Minister may at any time auspend or cancel a licence where, in his opinion, to do so is in the public interest.

11) An application for a licence to manage and conduct a raffle lotery shall be made in form $M R-1$.
12) An application for a licence to manage and conduct a lottery scheme at a bazaar shall be in form MBZ-1.

(b) in the case of a lottery scheme conducted by the charitable or religious organization at a baxaar,
(i) the amount or value of each prize awarded does not exceed one hundred dollars, and
(ii) the money or other valuable consideration paid to secure a chance to win a prize does not exceed fifty cents.
(2) Notwithstanding the provisions of subsection 1, the council shall not issue a licence to a charitable or religious organization where,
(a) the organization proposes to use the services of a person or organization to conduct and manage the lottery on its behalf, for a fee or other valuable cone sideration;
(b) the total value of all prizes to be awarded within the operation of a single bingo lottery, or of a raffle lottery, exceeds $\$ 3,500$ cash or merchandige or articles at equivalent market retail value;
(c) pyramiding of games is to be permitted; or
(d) games of a type or kind known as razzle dazzle, roll down, three-card monte, punch board, coin table or any dice ganes are to be operated.

## LICENCES

3) The Iicence shall be in the form prescribed by the Minister.
4) 

A copy of each licence issued shall be forwarded to the head of the appropriate law enforcement agency acting on behalf of the municipality, to the Department of Financial and Commercial Affairs, and to the Chief Inspector, Anti-Gambling, Ontario Provincial Police.
5)
(1) A bingo lottery licence may be issued for a single occasion, or for a number of occasions during a period not exceeding one calendar year.
(2) The licence shall specify the place where the bingo lottery is to be operated, the date or dates of operation, and the starting and finishing times.
6)

The Minister or the municipal council may impose terms and conditions on alicence.
7) (1) In addition to such special terms and conditions as may be imposed by the Minister or by the municipal council, each licence shall be subject to the following terms and conditions:
(a) the licensee shall comply with sections 179 and 179 A of the Criminal Code of Canada;
(b) The licensee shall comply with all the terms and provisions set out in the application for a license;
(c) the licensee shall maintain all funds raised in a separate account and shall maintain such records for such period of time as may be prescribed by the Minister;
(d) the gross receipts derived from the lottery shall be used for the charitable or religious object or purpose as set out by the licensee in the application for license, less the cost of the prizes awarded and such reasonable and necessary administrative expenses actually incurred in the management and conduct of the lottery, provided the expenses do not exceed such limits as may be prescribed by the Minister;
(e) such officers as the municipal council or the Minister may appoint, and all Peace 0fficers shall, at all reasonable times, have direct an unencumbered access to enquire into the nature, management and
conduct of the proceedings for which the licence has been granted, either prior to, during, or after the conclusion of such proceedings;
(f) the licensee shall submit to the licensing authority, not later than 30 days after the holding of each Iicensed lottery, a written report showing,
(i) the total gross receipts derived from the lottery,
(ii) the total cost of all prizes awarded
(iii) an itemized list of the administrative costs actually incurred in the management and conduct of the lottery
(iv) the total cash proceeds donated for charitable or religious purposes as set forth in the application of the licensee, and the name and address of the payee;
(g) the licensee shall conduct or allow to be conducted only the type of game or games provided in the application and the licence; and
(h) the licensee shall produce the licence upon demand
(2) Each raffle lottery licence shall also be subject to the following terms and conditions:
(a) each individual raffle scheme must have a 1icence;
(b) the winner or winners shall be determined and publicized in the manner set out in the application;

## (c) the charitable or religious organization managing and conducting the licensed raffle shall

(i) indicate on the face of the tickets the name and address of the organization, the location, the date, the time at which the draw is to be held, the number and nature of the prizes to be awarded, the number of the ticket, and the name of the printer; (ii) retain all unsold tickets and counterfoils of sold tickets for a period of not less than 90 days from the date of the draw, and produce them to such persons as may be authorized under section 7 (1)(e); and
(iv) indicate in its application the number of tickets to be printed for sale.

## SUSPENSION OR CANCELLATION OF LICENCE

8) 

The municipal council may suspend or cancel a licence for the breach of any term or condition.
9) The Minister may at any time suspend or cancel a licence where, in his opinion, to do so is in the public interest.

## APPLICATIONS

10) 

An application for a license to manage and conduct a bingo lottery shall be made in form MB-1.
11) An application for a licence to manage and conduct a raffle lottery shall be made in form MR-I.

An application for a licence to manage and conduct a lottery scheme at a bazaar shall be in form MBZ-1.

## LOTTERY LICENCE FEES

13) (1) Bingo Lotteries
(a) Where the total value of all prizes to be awarded within each operation does not exceed $\$ 500$ (Five Hundred Dollars) the licence fee shall be \$2.00 (Two Dollars). Where the total value of all prizes to be awarded is less than $\$ 25.00$ (Twentydive Dollars) the licence will be issued without charge.
(b) Where the total value of all prizes to be awarded within each operation exceeds $\$ 500.00$ (Five Hundred Dollars) but not more than $\$ 3,500.00$ (ThirtyFive Hundred) the licence fee shall be 2 percent (Two percent) of the total value of all prizes to be awarded."
(c) A licence for a series of bingo lotteries will be on the basis as in (a) or (b) above.

## Raffle Lotteries

(2) A licence fee equal to the sum of 2 percent (Two Percent) of the total value of all prizes to be awarded.

## Bazaars

(3) A 1icence fee of $\$ 2.00$ (Two Dollars)

Applications for licencing of lotteries in
excess of the monetary limits set hereto shall be subject to approval and recommendations of the Council of the Township of Westmeath, to be referred to the Ontario Department of Financial and Commercial Affairs.
