

THE CORPORATION OF THE TOWNSHIP OF WESTMEATH

BY-LAW NO. 72-21

Being a by-law to adopt the estimates of all sums required during the year and to strike the rates of taxation for the year 1972.

WHEREAS the Council of the Corporation of the Township of Westmeath has in accordance with the Municipal Act considered the estimates of the municipality and of the Boards and Commissions of the municipality and it is necessary that the following sums be raised by means of taxation for the year 1972.

General Purposes	\$ 69,512.75 ✓
County Purposes	\$ 52,072.25 ✓
Public School	\$ 39,520.00 ✓
Separate School (No. 2)	\$ 454.95 ✓
Separate School (No. 3 & 4)	\$ 2,517.51 ✓

AND WHEREAS the Assessment Roll made in 1971 and upon which the 1972 taxes are to be levied was finally revised by the Assessment Review Court.

AND WHEREAS the amount of Assessment entitled to benefit, hereinafter referred to as residential and farm, and the amount of assessment not entitled to benefit, hereinafter referred to as commercial and business from Unconditional Grants in accordance with Sections <sup>302</sup>~~294~~ and <sup>307</sup>~~297~~ of The Municipal Act, is as follows:

AND WHEREAS the Assessment of each of the bodies for which it is necessary to levy rates is as follows:

AND WHEREAS the amount of the Unconditional Grant is \$ 9,175.15 which is the equivalent of 3.77 mills on the Assessment Entitled to Benefit;

THEREFORE the Council of the Corporation of the Township of Westmeath ENACTS AS FOLLOWS:

1. That the estimates be adopted and the following amounts be levied therefore in the manner as set out hereinafter --

2. There shall be levied and collected upon the assessable lands, buildings and businesses within the Corporation of the Township of Westmeath the following rates for the Year 1972.

4. The collector and treasurer are hereby empowered to accept part payment from time to time on account of any taxes due.
