MUNICIPALITY OF Township of Westmeath  
BY-LAW NUMBER 997 73-6  
REGULATING PARKING

Council of the Corporation of the Municipality of ROSS WESTMEATH  
acts as follows:

DEFINITIONS

For the purpose of this by-law:-

Park or parking, when prohibited, means the standing of a vehicle, whether occupied or not, except when standing temporarily for the purpose of and while actually engaged in loading or unloading merchandise or passengers.

Street or highway includes a common or public highway, street, avenue, parkway, driveway, square, place, bridge, viaduct or trestle, designed and intended for, or used by, the general public for the passage of vehicles.

Vehicle includes a motor vehicle, trailer, traction engine, farm tractor, road-building machine and any vehicle drawn, propelled or driven by any kind of power, including muscular power, but does not include a motorized snow vehicle, the cars of electric or steam railways running only upon rails.

METHOD OF PARKING

No person shall park a vehicle on any street other than a one-way street unless on the right hand side of the street having regard for the direction in which the vehicle had been proceeding and unless the right front and right rear wheels or runners of the vehicle are parallel to and distand respectively not more than six inches from the edge of the roadway.

PARKING REGULATIONS

When properly worded signs have been erected and are on display no person shall park a vehicle on the highways or parts of highways hereinafter set out:-

"Town-line between Westmeath and Ross Townships from Highway 17 to Muskrat Lake".

PENALTIES

Any person violating any of the provisions of this by-law shall be subject to a penalty of not more than Ten Dollars for the first offence and not more than Fifty Dollars for every subsequent offence, exclusive of costs, and all such penalties shall be recoverable under the Ontario Summary Convictions Act.

This by-law shall not become effective untill approved by the Department of Transportation & Communications.
