BY-LAW NO. 17 - 74

A BY-LAW TO ESTABLISH ELECTORAL DIVISIONS FOR THE RENFREW COUNTY BOARD OF EDUCATION

WHEREAS the Secondary Schools and Boards of Education Act, R.S.O. 1970, as amended, Section 38 provides that the Council of the County shall determine the municipality or municipalities to be represented by each member to be elected in the school division by public school electors and separate school electors;

NOW THEREFORE the Council of the Corporation of the County of Renfrew hereby enacts as follows:

1.

That the municipality or municipalities to be represented by each member to be elected in the school division shall be as set out in Schedule "A" attached to and made part of this by-law.

2. That By-Law No. 15-72 and any other by-law inconsistent with this by-law are hereby repealed.

The Tile Drainage Act, 1971, Form 11


The Corporation of the Westmeath By-Law Number 74-17

By-law imposing special annual drainage rates upon land in respect of which money is borrowed under The Tile Drainage Act, 1971.

Whereas owners of land in the municipality have applied to the council under The Tile Drainage Act, 1971, for loans for the purpose of constructing sub-surface drainage works on such land; and whereas the council has upon their application lent the owners the total sum of $\frac{4.500.00}{500.00}$ to be repaid with interest by means of rates hereinafter imposed:

Be it therefore enacted, by the council, that annual rates as set out in the Schedule attached hereto are hereby imposed upon such land as described for a period of ten years, such rates to be levied and collected in the same manner as taxes.
