

By-Law No. 75-22

THE CORPORATION OF THE TOWNSHIP OF WESTMEATH

being a by-law to adopt the estimates of all sums required during the year and to strike the rates of taxation for the year 1975.

Whereas the council of the Township of Westmeath has in accordance with the Municipal Act considered the estimates of the municipality and of the various boards of the municipality and it is necessary that the following sums be raised by taxation for the year 1975.
