AN AGREEMENT BETWEEN THE TOWNSHIPS OF ROSS AND WESTMEATH FOR THE
PURPOSE OF PROVIDING EMERGENCY FIRE PROTECTION TO EACH TOWNSHIP

The basic purpose of this agreement is to have fire fighting equipment at the scene of a fire at the earliest possible moment. The fire department of the municipality in which the fire occurs will answer the call also if required and will relieve the emergency crew and equipment on arrival. This agreement will not effect Renfrew County Mutual Aid in any way.

Ross Township Fire Department will provide emergency service to Westmeath Township properties along the Ross and Westmeath town-line from Lot 1, Concession 1 E.M.L. (the Murray Buchwald property) to the Ottawa River, and the Township of Ross will assume the cost of this service.

Westmeath Township will provide emergency service to the portion of Ross Township west of Cobden on the west side of Muskrat Lake by including it with the area to be serviced by the Bromley-Westmeath pumper located at Cobden and manned by the Cobden Fire Department. Westmeath Township will assume the cost of this service.

This agreement will remain in effect until cancelled by either municipality by giving written notice to the other.
