

BY-LAW NO. 78-14

The Corporation of the Township of Westmeath

Being a by-law to adopt the estimates of all sums required during the year and to strike the rates of taxation for the year 1978.

Whereas the council of the Township of Westmeath has in accprdance with the Municipal Act considered the estimates of the municipality and of the various boards of the municipality and it is necessary that the following sums be raised by taxation for the year 1978.

Therefore the council of the Township of Westmeath enacts as follows.

1. That the estimates be adopted and the above mentioned amounts be levied in the manner set out hereinafter.
2. That there shall be levied and collected upon the assessment of the landa, buildings and businesses within the Corporation of Township of Westmeath the following rates for the year 1978.

3. That a penalty charge of 4% shall be charged on all current taxes remaining unpaid on the 20th. day of November 1978
4. The Collector and Treasurer are hereby empowered to accept part payment from time to time on account of taxes due.
