

BY-LAW NO. 79-18

The Corporation of the Township of Westmeath

Being a By-law to adopt the estimates of all sums required during the year, and to strike the rates of taxation for the year 1979.

Whereas the council of the Township of Westmeath has in accordance with The Municipal Act considered the estimates of the municipality and of the various boards of the municipality and it is necessary that the following sums be raised by taxation for the year 1979.

Therefore the Council of The Township of Westmeath enacts as follows.

1. That the estimates be adopted and the above mentioned amounts be levied in the manner set out hereinafter.
2. That there shall be levied and collected upon the assessment of the lands, buildings and businesses within the Corporation of The Township of Westmeath, the following rates for 1979.
